Dear Students and Parents of East Islip Middle School:

Although it is only December, at East Islip Middle School, we are already looking ahead to schedule our students for the 2019-2020 school year. For your convenience, the 2019-2020 curriculum guide has been updated and is available to be viewed on our schools website.

On Thursday, January 3, 2019, at 6:30 p.m. at East Islip High School, there is a very important informative meeting for all 8th grade students and their parents. The purpose of this meeting is to discuss 9th grade course offerings. Please mark this date on your calendar and make every effort to attend. The information given at this meeting is important for your child's 9th grade scheduling.

During the week of January 7th, the Middle School counselors will be working with our 8th grade students to help them input their High School electives into their online accounts. Scheduling for our 6th and 7th grade students will take place between February 11th and March 15th.

At the Middle School Level, New York State Department of Education mandates the majority of the courses that students take. However, in addition to our academic core program of English, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, World Language, and the required programs in Health and Physical Education, we also offer several exploratory experiences. Those courses include Art, Music, Technology, Family and Consumer Science

We anticipate a very "tight" schedule for the 2019-2020 school year. What this means is that our sections will be filled to capacity leaving little room for movement. Therefore, students should carefully consider the electives they select as they will not be able to make changes after the requests are locked. Elective courses should be selected based on student interest as opposed to electives their friends are planning to take.

Prior to the aforementioned dates, please read through the curriculum guide carefully with your child, so that together you can create the best possible schedule. Each person is unique in his or her own talents, interests, and aspirations. Don't be afraid of a challenge and start thinking ahead to your future.
