Dear East Islip Community,

The East Islip School District is happy to provide our sophomore and junior class with the opportunity to take the PSAT/NMSQT. The PSAT is a tool that is used by students across the country to prepare for the SAT exam, in addition to giving the juniors the opportunity to qualify for the National Merit Scholarship. Freshman will take the PSAT9 examination. This exam is formulated for the grade level and serves as further preparation for the SAT. East Islip School District is providing all freshmen, sophomore, and junior grade level students the opportunity to take this exam at no cost. The dates of the exams are:

October 24, 2023, for all freshmen  
October 25, 2023, for all juniors  
October 26, 2023, for all sophomores

The PSAT exam will be given during normal school operating hours from approximately 7:10 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. **All students are to report to the auditorium at 7:10 a.m.** No student will be admitted after 7:20 a.m. Upon completion, students will return to their normal scheduled classes for the rest of the day. Any student

that misses their lunch period will be served upon the conclusion of the exam prior to returning to class.

**There will be no makeup exams. Students that do not bring fully charged and updated school-issued devices will not be able to take the exam and will go to their regularly scheduled classes. Personal devices may not be used for this examination.**

On the day of the exam, we are requesting the following:

1. All students bring their fully charged school-issued laptop. Updated prior to the exam by leaving on for 24 hours and students have checked that the Bluebook Application works. Any issues should be emailed to [help@eischools.org](mailto:help@eischools.org). English teachers will conduct Bluebook Application checks with their classes.
2. A calculator is provided in the Bluebook Application, but students may bring an approved calculator to the test site if they wish:

3. Leave cell phones and smart watches home as they are not permitted in the test site.
